

Partner Education Grants

GUIDELINES AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA



The Partner Education Grants guidelines and eligibility criteria will assist you in preparing your application for the 2017 / 2018 Partner Education Grants.

Please read the following and ensure you meet the eligibility criteria.

Guidelines

- Partner Education Grants are to enhance employment opportunities through training or education carried out between 1 July 2017 and 30 June 2018.
- Partner Education Grants may award up to \$1000.00 per individual.
- Payment of Partner Education Grants will be made as a reimbursement for costs associated with training or education expenses including, but not limited to; course fees, purchase of textbooks and materials associated with the course, conference or professional membership registrations.
- Payment of Partner Education Grants will be made upon presentation of original tax invoice and receipt which demonstrates payment between 1 July 2017 and 30 June 2018, for training or education as outlined in application. The payment will be reimbursed to the applicants' nominated bank account.
- Training or education must be delivered by an accredited training provider (for example: TAFE, universities and skills-based organisations). Published course information must be included with the application.
- Partner Education Grants may not be used for training or education that could otherwise be funded by an employer.
- Partner Education Grants numbers are limited. All applications submitted to Rural Health West will be assessed to confirm eligibility.
- Applicants should anticipate that it will take a minimum of 28 days from receipt of a complete application (including completed application form and course information) for a decision to be made.
- Applicants will receive written notification from Rural Health West of the outcome of their application.

Please keep these guidelines for your information.

Eligibility

To meet eligibility criteria applicants:

- Must be a partner of a currently practising West Australian rural medical practitioner or specialist.
- Must be living in a regional, rural or remote West Australian location along with their medical practitioner or specialist partner.
- Must not have received a Rural Health West Bursary in the past financial years (July 2016 to June 2017).
- Need to fully complete and submit the Partner Education Grants application form and enclose training or education information as published by the training provider.
- Do not need to have already commenced their studies to apply, but will need to commence within this (2017-2018) financial year.
- Must be able to provide Rural Health West with original tax invoices to demonstrate payment of the training or education as approved in their application.

- Must not be in receipt of any other scholarships, bursary or grant to support this training or education.
- Must give permission, if successful, to be contacted by Rural Health West staff to provide a brief article and photo as a Partner Education Grants recipient to be used as promotional material for Rural Health West.
