

Annual Photography Competition

Terms and Conditions



Rural Health West's Annual Photography Competition is opening on Monday 20 September 2021.

- 1 By entering the competition, the entrant accepts and agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.
- 2 To be eligible to enter the competition, the entrant must be a practising health professional (or an immediate family member) in rural Western Australia and have personally taken the photograph(s) that he or she intends to submit.
- 3 Previous entrants are eligible to submit photographs to the competition; however, winners of the 2020, 2019 and 2018 competition are not eligible for first prize.
- 4 The competition will close at 5.00pm on Friday 22 October 2021. Late entries will not be accepted.
- 5 Up to five photographs may be submitted by any entrant.
- 6 Entries, along with a fully completed entry form listing all entries, may be submitted:
 - electronically to the Rural Health West Marketing team at marketing@ruralhealthwest.com.au, (up to 50MB per email); or
 - on a USB and posted to the Marketing team at Rural Health West, PO Box 433, Nedlands, Western Australia 6909.
 - **Please note:** USBs will not be returned.
- 7 To be eligible to enter the competition, the photograph(s) must be in a high resolution format at 300dpi (ensure your camera is set to the highest quality) so they can be reproduced for high quality print and be in line with the theme *Show city folks what's great about living in rural WA*.
- 8 Entries which do not comply with these terms will not be accepted.
- 9 Rural Health West takes no responsibility for lost or late entries or corrupt digital files.
- 10 It is the entrant's responsibility to obtain the necessary permissions from people who appear in a photograph.
- 11 By entering this competition, the entrant warrants that such permissions have been obtained in writing and agrees to provide copies to Rural Health West upon request.
- 12 Twelve entries will be selected for inclusion in the Rural Health West 2022 desk calendar along with the name and picture of the photographer. The top 12 entrants will be contacted following the competition closing date advising them of successful selection.
- 13 Entries may be submitted in both landscape and portrait orientation; however, Rural Health West prefers entries that are of landscape orientation due to the size requirements of the desk calendar.
- 14 Entries selected to feature in the desk calendar may need to be cropped to suit the size requirements of the desk calendar.
- 15 All entrants to the competition agree to give Rural Health West the right to reproduce their image in print and online marketing material to promote awareness of rural Western Australian health careers and lifestyle. This right is non-exclusive and images will not be shared with any third party or used for profit.
- 16 Where reasonable (in Rural Health West's view), photographs published under these terms will include a photographer credit.
- 17 One major prize will be awarded to the entrant judged to have captured the essence of the theme *Show city folks what's great about living in rural WA* in the best way. The winning photographer will receive a \$500 gift voucher and a framed copy of their winning photograph. A Rural Health West judging panel will select the winning photograph, which will feature on the cover of the Rural Health West 2022 desk calendar.
- 18 A \$200 gift voucher will be given to the People's Choice Award recipient, which will be selected from the number of 'Likes' on the Rural Health West Facebook page as at 5.00pm on Monday 8 November 2021.
- 19 Rural Health West will select up to three images from each participant entries to upload to Facebook as they are submitted and will be available for people to 'Like' from Monday 27 September 2021.
- 20 Rural Health West's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 21 Winners to be announced Tuesday 9 November 2021.
